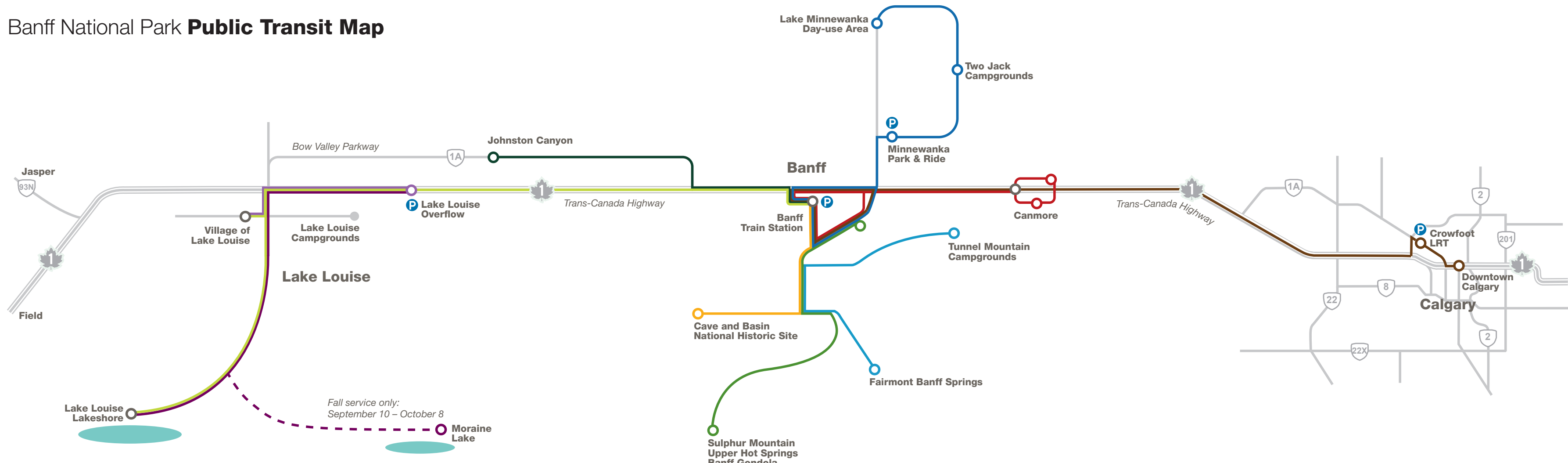




Banff National Park Public Transit Map

This guide will help you get around to popular locations and hidden gems on public transit. Give your vehicle a vacation—leave the driving to us.

Transit and Shuttle Routes

Use Parks Canada shuttles and Roam public transit in Banff National Park to get to these popular places.

- ### Parks Canada Shuttles
- Banff—Johnston Canyon**: Start at the Banff train station, enjoy the winding Bow Valley Parkway and see one of the most popular destinations in the park, Johnston Canyon.
 - Banff—Lake Louise**: Grab the shuttle at the Banff train station and travel directly to the lakeshore, with a quick stop at Samson Mall in the Village of Lake Louise.
 - Lake Louise Lakeshore**: Catch a shuttle from the Lake Louise overflow parking area to the iconic Lake Louise lakeshore.
 - Lake Louise Village**: From the Lake Louise overflow parking area, catch the shuttle to Samson Mall in the Village of Lake Louise.

Roam Public Transit (See other side for details)

- Route 1: Sulphur Mountain**: From the hotels on Banff Avenue, access the shops of downtown Banff, the Banff Upper Hot Springs and the Banff Gondola on Sulphur Mountain.
- Route 2: Tunnel Mountain**: Access downtown Banff directly from the Tunnel Mountain campgrounds. Visit the sights and trails and travel to the Fairmont Banff Springs. Registered campers enjoy free departures from campgrounds—fares apply for all other rides.
- Route 3: Banff—Canmore Regional**: This route travels between the towns of Banff and Canmore. Up to 6 bikes can be on this bus—ride the Legacy Trail and travel back on Roam public transit. This route connects with **Route 5: Canmore Local Service**. Details at roamtransit.com
- Route 4: Cave and Basin**: Enjoy a dose of history on this route. This bus connects the Banff train station to downtown Banff, the Banff Park Museum and the Cave and Basin national historic sites.
- Route 6: Lake Minnewanka**: Catch this bus from the Banff train station, Banff Avenue or the Minnewanka Park & Ride and spend the day enjoying Lake Minnewanka, Two Jack Lake or Cascade Ponds. Registered campers enjoy free departures from campgrounds—fares apply for all other rides.

Additional Transit

On-It Regional Transit: Calgary—Banff: Leave your vehicle in Calgary and enjoy a car-free visit to Banff. This weekend and holiday service runs between downtown Calgary, Crowfoot LRT station and downtown Banff.

Parks Canada Shuttles

Banff—Johnston Canyon: Service between the Banff train station and Johnston Canyon. 45 minute travel time. Daily between May 18 – October 8. Price: \$5 round trip, free for youth 17 and under.

Lake Louise Lakeshore: Service between the Lake Louise overflow parking area and Lake Louise lakeshore. Daily between May 18 – October 8. Price: Free.

Minnewanka Park & Ride

- Route 6 service from 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. (see schedule).
- Lot open 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. daily.
- Gates are locked nightly from 10:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m.
- Camping, including sleeping in vehicles, is prohibited.
- Fires are prohibited.

Travelling with Bicycles

- Up to 3 bicycles at a time may be transported on Roam buses equipped with exterior bike racks.
- Banff-Canmore Regional Route 3 Roam buses with interior and exterior racks can take up to 6 bikes.
- Once Roam bus racks are full, passengers with bicycles will have to wait for the next available bus with space.
- Parks Canada shuttles and On-It Regional Transit cannot accommodate bicycles.
